### Sacrament of Baptism

The desire for Baptism for a child must be accompanied by a very serious commitment to raise the child within the Catholic faith community and to educate the child in the truths of the church. An essential part of the commitment is regular attendance at Sunday Mass. Baptisms are held on the 4th Sunday of every month. Please contact the parish office for a Baptismal package.

#### **Sacrament of Matrimony**

Couples planning to be married should contact the parish one year in advance. They must also attend a Marriage Preparation Course prior to entering marriage. If either party has previously gone through any form of civil divorce or religious marriage with another person, please notify the priest as soon as possible as the priest is not permitted to set a wedding date until the Bishop's Office has been contacted.

#### Sacrament of the Sick

In this Sacrament we celebrate Christ's healing presence among us today. If you, a relative or friend, require this Sacrament at home or nursing home, please call the parish office. For your spiritual needs during a hospital stay, the Archdiocese of Toronto has assigned a full time Roman Catholic Chaplain to each of the two Mississauga hospitals. # THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

**December 17, 2017** 

### "Prepare the Way Of The Lord"

Joy



Advent is the season of the prophets, and the Scripture readings of these weeks before Christmas help us to focus our vision and deepen our longing for the Messiah. In this week's Gospel, John the Baptist announces the coming of the anointed one,

the Messiah. "He came as witness to testify to the light, so that all might believe through him (John 1:7). The light John speaks about refers to Jesus. John makes it clear that he is not the Messiah but is preparing the way for the Messiah, Jesus Christ. The religious leaders question John's authority and ask who he is; is he a prophet announcing the Messiah's arrival (see Malachi 4:5, Deuteronomy 18:15)? Was he really sent by God? John has no doubt about what is his call and mission. In answer, John states that he is only a voice bidding people to get ready for the arrival of the greatest Ruler of all, God's anointed King and Messiah.

The prophecy of John's message and the arrival of Jesus is found in the last book of the Old Testament - "See, I am sending my messenger, to prepare the way before me, and the Lord whom you seek, will suddenly come to his temple. The messenger of the covenant in whom you delight - indeed he is coming," says the Lord of hosts." (Malachi 3:1). The prophecy is also found in Isaiah - "A voice cries out: 'In the wilderness prepare the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.'" (Isaiah 40:3). John's role is to help the people prepare for the

arrival of Jesus. The true identity of Jesus was not known until he was baptised by John and began

his public ministry. John acknowledged the greatness of Jesus and announced his coming, calling the people to repent so their hearts would be ready to encounter God in the flesh. In a similar way, we are called to prepare our hearts during Advent through repentance as we prepare to encounter Christ in Christmas.

John the Baptist's life and mission reminds us how badly we need a Saviour to save us, in order that we might be all that we are called to be and do all that we have to do to live in the Light.

Yes, joyful are those who live like this! Joyful indeed are those whose God is the Lord.


