Sacrament of Baptism

The desire for Baptism for a child must be accompanied by a very serious commitment to raise the child within the Catholic faith community and to educate the child in the truths of the church. An essential part of the commitment is regular attendance at Sunday Mass. Baptisms are held on the 4th Sunday of every month. Please contact the parish office for a Baptismal package.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples planning to be married should contact the parish one year in advance. They must also attend a Marriage Preparation Course prior to entering marriage. If either party has previously gone through any form of civil divorce or religious marriage with another person, please notify the priest as soon as possible as the priest is not permitted to set a wedding date until the Bishop's Office has been contacted.

Sacrament of the Sick

In this Sacrament we celebrate Christ's healing presence among us today. If you, a relative or friend, require this Sacrament at home or nursing home, please call the parish office. For your spiritual needs during a hospital stay, the Archdiocese of Toronto has assigned a full time Roman Catholic Chaplain to each of the two Mississauga hospitals. SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

January 19, 2020

"Here is the Lamb of God..."

John calls Jesus the Lamb of God and thus signifies Jesus' mission as the One who redeems us from our sins. The blood of the Passover Lamb (Exodus 12) delivered the Israelites in Egypt from slavery and death. The Lord Jesus freely offered up his life for us on the cross as the atoning sacrifice for our sins (1 Corinthians 5:7). The blood which he poured out for us on the cross cleanses, heals, and frees us from our slavery to sin, and from the "wages of sin which is death" (Romans 6:23) and the "destruction of both body and soul in hell" (Matthew 10:28).

John points to Jesus' saving mission - to offer up his life as the atoning sacrifice for our sins

It is significant that John was the son of Zachariah, a priest of Israel who participated in the daily sacrifice of a lamb in the temple for the sins of the people (Exodus 29). John recognized that Jesus was the perfect unblemished lamb offered by the Father in heaven as the one and only sacrifice that could cancel the debt of sin, and free us from death and the destruction of body and soul in hell.

The Holy Spirit reveals who Jesus truly is - the Son of God and Saviour of the world.

When John says he did not know Jesus (John 1:31,33) he was referring to the hidden reality of Jesus' divinity. But the Holy Spirit in that hour revealed to John Jesus' true nature, such that John bore witness that this is the Son of God. How can we be certain that Jesus is truly the Christ, the Son of the living God? The Holy Spirit makes the Lord Jesus Christ known to us through the gift of faith. God gives us his Spirit as our helper and guide who opens our hearts and minds to receive and comprehend the great mystery and plan of God - to unite all things in his Son, our Lord Jesus Christ (Ephesians 1:10).

Do you want to grow in the knowledge and love of Jesus Christ? Ask the Lord to pour his Holy Spirit upon you to deepen your faith, hope, and love for God and for the plan he has for your life.

"Lord Jesus Christ, fill me with the power of your Holy Spirit and let me grow in the knowledge of your great love and truth. Let your Spirit be aflame in my heart that I may know and love you more fervently and strive to do your will in all things."

THE RITE OF ACCEPTANCE IN THE RCIA PROCESS

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is the process whereby adults who are not Catholic explore the Catholic faith with the hope of eventually being baptized or received into the Catholic Church. Catholic adults who are baptized, but who have not yet received Eucharist or Confirmation, may also participate in the RCIA if no other process is available for their specific needs.

During the RCIA process, formal ceremonies called "rites" take place, usually during Sunday Mass. The purpose of these rites is to introduce RCIA participants to the parish and remind the community of the important role we all have in initiating new members.

On Sunday, January 19, at the 12 Noon Mass, Brent Mattison will celebrate the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens. The prerequisite for this rite is that the beginnings of the spiritual life and fundamentals of Christian teaching have taken root in the candidates for baptism. Brent has been participating in catechetical and faith-formation sessions since September and has been attending Sunday Mass regularly.

Until now, Brent has been called an "inquirer" in the RCIA process. After celebrating the Rite of Acceptance, Brent will formally be known as a "catechumen". Brent looks forward to receiving the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the next Easter Vigil. Please continue to pray for Brent and his family as he continues his faith journey.
