Sacrament of Baptism

The desire for Baptism for a child must be accompanied by a very serious commitment to raise the child within the Catholic faith community and to educate the child in the truths of the church. An essential part of the commitment is regular attendance at Sunday Mass. Baptisms are usually held on two Sundays every month. Please contact the parish office for a Baptismal package.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples planning to be married should contact the parish one year in advance. They must also attend a Marriage Preparation Course prior to entering marriage. If either party has previously gone through any form of civil divorce or religious marriage with another person, please notify the priest as soon as possible as the priest is not permitted to set a wedding date until the Bishop's Office has been contacted.

Sacrament of the Sick

In this Sacrament we celebrate Christ's healing presence among us today. If you, a relative or friend, require this Sacrament at home or nursing home, please call the parish office. For your spiritual needs during a hospital stay, the Archdiocese of Toronto has assigned a full time Roman Catholic Chaplain to each of the two Mississauga hospitals. A Note from the Pastor about Purgatory: A Gift of God's Mercy

The Commemoration of the Faithful Departed, or All Souls Day, is celebrated every year on November 2nd. The term "faithful departed" refers to the souls in **Purgatory**. All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still are imperfectly purified, are assured of their eternal salvation, but, after death, they undergo purification to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven.

Even though sins have already been forgiven by God in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, the damage caused by these sins must still be atoned for, either in this life or in the life to come. In this life, atonement can be satisfied by prayers, good deeds, sacrifices and acts of penance. Purgatory is a gift of God's goodness and mercy which allows us to atone for our sins even after our death.

The Catholic Church bases her teaching about Purgatory on the biblical teaching of prayer for the dead (2 Maccabees 12:38-46; 2 Timothy 1:18). If heaven and hell were the only possibilities after death, there would be no reason to pray for the dead. Those in heaven need no prayers, and those in hell are beyond the reach of prayers. In Matthew 12:31-32, Jesus said that blasphemy against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven in this age nor in the age to come, implying that the process of forgiveness for some sins continues "in the age to come", in Purgatory.

Catholic teaching speaks of a "state" of purification, not a place. The souls in Purgatory are without physical bodies and therefore have no physical location. Nor can we say that the suffering of Purgatory involves physical fire. The "fire" of Purgatory is the fire of God's love. Just as physical fire burns away impurities, God's love will "burn away" the imperfections which keep us from being perfectly open to the presence, love and joy of God.

The souls in Purgatory are called the "poor souls" because they are suffering. They have glimpsed the loving presence of the Eternal God with whom they are destined to share eternal life, and any time apart from God is painful. The more they are purified, the more intense their love grows, and the more painful is their longing for God.

The souls in Purgatory cannot pray for themselves, but they can and do pray for us, so that we can make choices in our earthly life which will help us avoid the pain they are now suffering. In every Mass, we pray for those who have died. By praying and offering masses for the souls in Purgatory, their time apart from God can be reduced or concluded.
