### Sacrament of Baptism

The desire for Baptism for a child must be accompanied by a very serious commitment to raise the child within the Catholic faith community and to educate the child in the truths of the church. An essential part of the commitment is regular attendance at Sunday Mass. Baptisms are usually held on two Sundays every month. Please contact the parish office for a Baptismal package.

### Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples planning to be married should contact the parish one year in advance. They must also attend a Marriage Preparation Course prior to entering marriage. If either party has previously gone through any form of civil divorce or religious marriage with another person, please notify the priest as soon as possible as the priest is not permitted to set a wedding date until the Bishop's Office has been contacted.

### Sacrament of the Sick

In this Sacrament we celebrate Christ's healing presence among us today. If you, a relative or friend, require this Sacrament at home or nursing home, please call the parish office. For your spiritual needs during a hospital stay, the Archdiocese of Toronto has assigned a full time Roman Catholic Chaplain to each of the two Mississauga hospitals. # RCIA RITES DURING MASS ON THE WEEKEND OF NOVEMBER 23RD & 24TH 2023

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is a process whereby adults explore the Catholic faith with the hope of being baptized or received into the Catholic Church. Baptized Catholics may also participate to receive instruction and faith formation to complete their initiation.

During the initiation process, formal ceremonies called "rites" take place, usually during designated Sunday Masses, to introduce RCIA participants to the parish, update parishioners on the progress of those being initiated and to remind the community of the important role we all have in initiating new members. **Saturday, November 23rd, during the 5pm Mass, Jonah Lessard,** who is preparing for baptism at the next Easter Vigil, will celebrate the Rite of Acceptance. Sunday, November 24th, during the **10am Mass, the following baptized candidates hoping to be received into full communion with the Catholic Church will celebrate the Rite of Welcome: Shaughn Chan, Christopher Hanson & Timothy Oladosu.** 

At the 12pm Mass on Sunday, November 24th, Victor Dimude and Augustina Dimude, who are baptized Catholics, will receive a blessing as they prepare to complete their initiation with the Sacraments of Confirmation and the Holy Eucharist.
